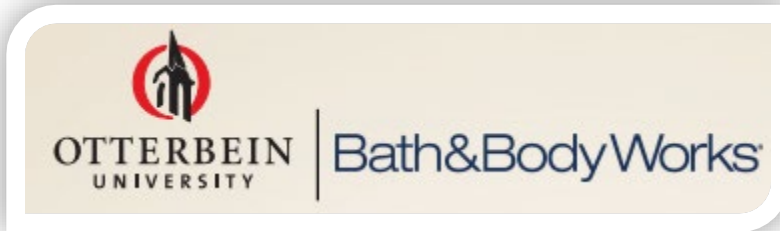

The Otterbein Advantage Scholarship

Q. Why choose Otterbein?

A.

- According to the US News and World Report Best College 2022-2023: Otterbein was ranked top 10 in Midwest Regional University, Most Innovative Schools, and Best Undergrad teaching.
- 13:1 student to faculty ratio and average class size of 18 – 20.
- 21st century education, access to education built on Otterbein's innovative integrative studies curriculum, hands-on experiential education, and more that 60 undergraduate majors and 45+ minors.
- 96.3% of the class of 2022 reported that they were either employed, serving in the military, or in graduate school within six months of graduation.

Q. Who is eligible?

A.

- Bath and Body Works current active associates, their spouse/domestic partner, and their dependent children are able to take advantage of this transformative educational opportunity.
- Admissibility is strongly based off of academic performance and academic interest, then secondly extracurriculars, special circumstances, and accolades.

Q. What are the eligibility requirements?

A:

- Full and Part-time Associates must be verified as a Bath & Body Works employee and/or employee spouse/domestic partner/dependent at the time of admission.
 - Dependents must be under the age of 24, IRS dependents, and have not completed an undergraduate degree.
- Meet Otterbein admissibility criteria.
- For transfer students, registered for all classes for the term by August 1 for Fall semester, December 1 for Spring semester, or May 1 for Summer term, each year of enrollment.

Q. What is the selection criteria?**A. Academic Performance**

- Admitted students have a medium academic profile of 3.38-4.02 GPA, ACT Range 20-27, and SAT range of 960-1210
- Most academic programs are test optional besides the honors program, education, nursing, and competitive full tuition scholarships.
- Students with a GPA below 2.75 are encouraged to submit a test score

Q. What is the scholarship awarded amount and what percentage discount is that from full tuition cost?

- A. \$19,000 renewable for 8 semesters**. This scholarship represents a 55% discount off of Otterbein's tuition, as of 2024. Students net tuition price is \$15,424 before state, federal, or institutional need-based aid or loans.
- Students receive a 15% discount per credit hour for up to 9 credits per semester

*** Students are responsible for additional costs that may include textbooks and supplies, mandatory technology and student life fees, and room and board if they choose to live on campus*

Q. How is the scholarship renewed?

A. Scholarship is automatically added to financial aid each academic year that the student remains full time and maintains a minimum 2.75 GPA for undergraduates and 3.0 for graduate students. Dependents must maintain full-time student status.

Q. What is the selection process?

A.

- First-time freshmen apply to Otterbein through the Common App. Upon selecting Otterbein, they will be asked additional questions: Do you qualify for the Advantage Partnership and select Advantage Partner, Bath & Body Works.
- Transfer students may indicate interest in the advantage scholarships when speaking to their appointed counselor.

Q. Is there a limit to how many associates can be awarded the Advantage Scholarship?

A. There is currently no limit to the number of students that can be awarded the advantage scholarship.
